Edinburgh, Thursday 23 March 2023 – Jupiter Artland opens to the public on 7 April for Easter Weekend with 3 days of free, nature-inspired learning activities, Easter trail, Enchanted Storytelling and even a visit from the Easter Bunny.

Jupiter Artland reveals today (24 March) its activities for the Easter Holidays to coincide with the sculpture park reopening to the public from 7 April 2023. With a mission for Every Child in Scotland to experience the wellbeing benefits of art, creativity and nature, Jupiter's 2023 season begins with a three-day celebration of learning. Highlights of Easter at Jupiter include Easter trails around the Artland, free nature-inspired creative workshops for children of all ages, Enchanted Storytelling in Jupiter's Forest, as well as a Spring-inspired pop-up shop, and new seasonal menu at Café Party.

In addition to the Easter Weekend activities, Jupiter Artland is offering a full programme of holiday courses for children to be creative in the outdoors.
