"STATION" on 9th January, 2024, at The Bindery, 53 Hatton Garden, London EC1N 8HN, this showcase promises an immersive experience that transcends traditional boundaries.

About the Artist:

Andrew Hewish, holds a Ph.D. from the Royal College of Art (RCA). He is a Senior Lecturer in Fine Art, School of Art, Architecture, and Design, London Metropolitan University, and founding artistic director of the Centre for Recent Drawing. In 2020, Hewish was awarded a British Empire Medal for his exceptional contribution to the arts. His works, collected globally, grace prestigious institutions including the Victoria and Albert Museum and The Warburg Institute.

Exhibition Highlights:

This solo exhibition features a major work "STATION", which draws inspiration from Hewish's transformative journeys along the Portofino coast and to Kyoto, influenced by Hiroshige's Japanese woodblocks. Across 24 panels, "STATION" challenges traditional notions of art-viewing, encouraging a profound engagement with scale, time, motion, and space.

Dive into the diverse art forms of drawing, painting, and sculpture, as Hewish's enigmatic creations explore the realms of ecology, site, studio, and the line. His work, a dance between archaism and lyricism, invites viewers to contemplate each object's sumptuous materiality.

Interview Insights:

In an insightful interview, Hewish reflects on the origins of "STATION", taking us via the ferry to a Ligurian monastery cove to broader reveries of transit - the vaporetti in Venice and the mouettes of Lake Geneva.
