An artist whose exhibition titles are statements and sentences that get the head-scratching going (see above).

### ABOUT CEDRIC CHRISTIE

Cedric Christie is a London-based artist who originally trained as a welder. His current studio is located in a working steel factory in the East London suburb of Dagenham – historically the home of the Ford Motor Company.

Christie uses found materials to explore the boundaries of modernism and minimalism, made manifest in pieces that include embroideries, works on paper, snooker ball assemblages and scaffolding.

*The Card Players I, after Cézanne*, a steel and paint sculpture, was acquired by RISD Museum, Rhode Island in 2024. Recent shows include *Oblivious to My Own Career* with Rocket Gallery, *more happy, more curious* at Raumx and *Infallible* with Liminal Gallery in Margate.
